Post Circumcision Care

1. At every diaper change, squeeze ointment onto a gauze pad and place directly over the circumcision area.
2. There will be blood like stains on the gauze pad and on the diaper. This is a result of urine passing through the bandage. This is not fresh blood, even though it has a reddish colour.
3. The circular bandage around the circumcision will be removed by me, the next day or so. There is no need for concern if the circular bandage falls off on its own, as long as there is no active bleeding. The bandage dissolves on its own and just slips off.
4. Even after the bandage is off, keep placing gauze with ointment on the circumcision area. I will return the next day to check and ensure that all is OK.

Post Circumcision care, after bandage is removed

1. Continue to apply gauze and ointment for three days only, not longer.
2. After 24 hours of the bandage being removed, Place the baby in a warm soapy bath for five minutes so that the area can get cleansed. This should be done once a day, every day at least for one week.
3. Disregard any greenish yellowish colour around the wound area, as that will eventually disappear.
